SPECIFIC PROJECTS NEEDING SUPPORT

1) **Twenty New Latin America Mentoring Communities –**

Paul & Nydia Johnson, LFM Mentors

Pray for the Lord to raise up and fund 20 Mentors from among Paul and Nydia Johnson's connections who will each lead a mentoring community of about 8 to 12 future mentors, in the following countries. *Funding needed: \$5000/group/year for up to 3 years, totaling \$300,000.*

2) **“GénérationMentor”** - Alain Stamp, LFM Mentor, & Jennifer Williamson

Alain Stamp, a French Evangelist, Mentor, and Musician, is mentoring leaders from several major church unions in France and members of the CNEF (National Council of French Evangelicals). They recently contacted him “with the same request, ‘Alain, we would like to develop a culture of mentoring to accompany our pastors and leaders. You are the benchmark for mentoring in France, let us draw from your well!’ ” Alain asks us to pray for these key leaders who will enter into this discovery of spiritual mentorship and that church denominations are eager to nurture healthy leaders. Alain states, “This is a real cultural revolution for our country and I believe that the understanding and vision of the need for mentoring is really taking root in France!” *Funding needed to support the GénérationMentor project: \$12,000/year*

3) M2E -- Quebec Mentoring Program – Rafael Anzenberger, LFM Mentor

Pray for the mentoring program M2E (multiplier les Évangélistes pour les Églises locales) that Raphael recently launched in Quebec. M2E trains and equips churches to develop the ministry role of Evangelist. The 2-year program focuses on developing the evangelist's Christ-like character and biblical leadership and strengthening their theological, evangelism, and leadership skills. M2E immerses them in a network of evangelists (called France Evangélisation) to draw inspiration, creativity, and ideas for their local contexts.

Raphael has launched two cohorts comprised of 10 churches per cohort, adding one cohort yearly. The cohorts are responsible for 50% of the cost of participating in M2E and LFM is helping to raise the remaining 50%. *Over the next 5 years, the LFM funds needed to put 60 churches through the 2-year program is \$60,000.*

4) African Apologetics Initiative – Rafael Anzenberger, LFM Mentor

Pray for a special mentoring program of young leaders in Africa *that had to close recently due to a lack of finances*. AAI is a group of young people with a heart for theology and apologetics. They research, produce, translate, and publish apologetic resources adapted to Christians' spiritual, intellectual, and cultural realities in sensitive areas of Africa. Before closing, AAI members met within their various countries, 3-4 times/year, and multi-nationally, once/year, to encourage each other and share the work done by AAI members. Their expenses include the costs of part-time mentors and assistants, travel, and publishing. *The funding needed to restart and continue the program is \$30,000 per year.*
